The Butler County Educational Service Center (BCESC) partners with the Shared Harvest Foodbank to provide students in need with bags of food to help supplement the food supply of families (Backpack Program). The BCESC distributes bags of food to students through the Success and Head Start Programs. The Success Program places staff members, referred to as liaisons, in school buildings throughout Butler County. Their role is to help students and families access resources to help them move forward and to help students achieve in school. Common needs are food, clothing, housing, access to doctors/dentists, tutoring, etc. Head Start helps low income preschool aged children be better equipped to enter kindergarten.

These two programs serve many families who must skip meals or reduce the size of meals to make food last longer, because they do not have enough money to buy food. The partnership between the BCESC and the Shared Harvest Food Bank addresses this issue. Students in need are identified by these programs through a screening process. Shared Harvest purchases the food and also receives donations. Shared Harvest staff and volunteers assemble bags of food each week. The bags contain kid-friendly food items, such as granola bars, pudding, mandarin oranges, etc., that is easy to prepare. School staff and volunteers pick up the bags of food each week and deliver them to Butler County school buildings and Head Start sites. Success and Head Start program staff then ensure that the bags go home in the backpacks of the designated students each week on Fridays.

The retail value of each bag is approximately \$6.50. However, through donations and because Shared Harvest is able to buy in bulk, the actual cost per bag is approximately \$3.50. Through the partnership, Shared Harvest contributes \$2.00/bag, making the cost per bag for the Success/Head Start Programs \$1.50. During the 2017-2018 school year, over 1200 food bags were distributed to students on a weekly basis.

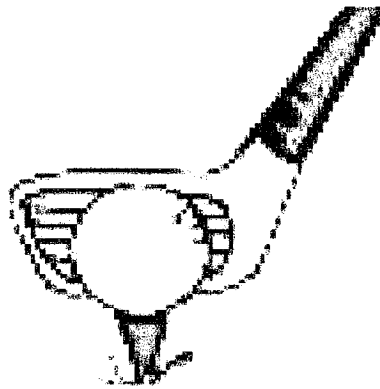
