

Bullying Report 2016-17

Monroe Primary Bullying Occurrences for 2016-17:

There have been 3 bully occurrences from August 2016 to May 2017.

When bullying occurs, parents are contacted and a conference was held with the student. Training continues for students through the building wide social skills program. The teachers provide students with additional social skills training during structured class time. The classroom instruction is in combination with daily social skill tips that are shared on the announcements, along with electronic resource ideas, books, songs and games/activities that are sent to the classroom teacher to help promote a bully-free environment.

Monroe Elementary Bullying Occurrences for 2016-2017:

There has been 3 bully occurrence involving 3 students from August 2016 to May 2017.

Discipline included the following:

- Detention (2)
- Out-of-school Suspension (1)

With the above mentioned discipline issue, parents were contacted (phone conference and in school meeting), and a conference was held with the student. Training continues weekly for all students through our Anti-Bully Program. The Anti-Bully Committee also meets monthly to help teachers with ideas and activities to use in the classroom to promote a bully-free environment.

Monroe Junior High School Bullying Occurrences for 2016-17:

There were 2 bullying occurrences involving 4 students from August 2016 to May 2017.

Discipline included: Detention
Suspension

With the above discipline parents were contacted and students were conferenced with. One of the students was also referred to our school counselor for continued support with appropriate social behavior.

Monroe Senior High School Bullying Occurrences for 2016-17:
