

Bullying Report 2017-18 1st Semester

Monroe Primary Bullying Occurrences for 2017-18 1st Semester:

There have been 0 bully occurrences from August to January 2018.

When bullying occurs, parents are contacted and a conference was held with the student. Training continues for students through the building wide social skills program. The teachers provide students with additional social skills training during structured class time.

Monroe Elementary Bullying Occurrences for 2017-2018 1st Semester:

There have been 2 bully occurrences involving 2 students from August 2017 to December 2017. Discipline included the following:

- Emergency Removal
- Conference with student in office

With the above mentioned discipline issues, parents were contacted (phone conference and/or in school meetings), and a conference was also held with the student. Training continues weekly for all students through our Anti-Bully Program to promote a bully-free environment.

Monroe Junior High School Bullying Occurrences for 2017-18 1st Semester:

There have been 4 occurrences of bullying involving 3 students from August 2017 to December 2017. None of the incidents were involving issues of race, religion, or sexual orientation.

Discipline includes the following:

- In School Suspension 5 days
- Out of School Suspension 8 days

With the above discipline, parents were contacted and students were conferenced with. One of the students was monitored during the day to minimize his contact with those students whom he bullied.

Monroe Senior High School Bullying Occurrences for 2017-18 1st Semester:

- There was 1 bullying occurrence during the first semester of 2017-2018 school year.
- Discipline Included:
 - Out of school suspension 10/30 - 11/6
 - In School Suspension 11/8 - 11/10 (11/7 was election day - No School)
 - Currently JDC as a result of this incident. Not the decision of the school.

With the above discipline the incident occurred on Friday October 27th. Administration was made aware of the situation after school that day and dealt with the bullying incident on Monday morning October 30th. Parents were contacted and student was conferenced with. Parents had to pick up their child that day from school.
