

Bullying Report 2014-15

Monroe Elementary Bullying Occurrences for 2014-2015

There have been 19 bully occurrences involving 8 students for the second semester of the 2014-15 school year.

Discipline included the following:

- Bus Suspension 3
- Loss of privileges 6
- Conference with student and/or parent 9
- Detention 1

With the above mentioned discipline issues, parents were contacted and a conference was held with the student. Training continues in the classroom several times a month for students through the Olweus Program. The Olweus Committee also meets monthly to help teachers with ideas and activities to use in the classroom to promote a bully-free environment.

Monroe Primary Bullying Occurrences for 2014-15

There have been 0 bully occurrences from January to May of 2015.

Discipline included the following:

- * Bus Suspension 3
- * Loss of privileges 3

With the above mentioned discipline issues, parents were contacted and a conference was held with the student. Training continues for students through the building wide social skill program. The teachers provide students with additional social skills training during structured class time. The classroom instruction is in combination with daily social skill tips that are shared on the announcements, along with electronic resource ideas, books, songs and games/activities that are sent to the classroom teacher to help promote a bully-free environment.
